



Payment Plans

Students and their families have 2 payment options available to them.

OPTION I

Balance paid in full by the following due dates:

August 9

January 9

OPTION II

Enrollment in the Bryant University Payment Plan managed by the Bursar's Office. The benefits of in-house management, allows for plan enrollment directly within the Student Account Center. The Bryant University Payment Plan offers more flexibility with 5, 4 or 3 monthly installments throughout the semester. Both students and authorized users can use the payment plan option to manage the student's account.

Payment Plan Facts:

- No finance charges.
- An enrollment fee of \$50 per semester is required.
- Payments on the plan must be made, on-line, by using the Webcheck (ACH) or credit card payment option. ACH payments can only be made through a U.S. bank account.
- Enrollment in the monthly payment plan must be completed each semester.
- An email notification will automatically be sent five days before the due date of the next installment payment and each time a payment is made.
- A \$40 late fine will be assessed for each installment that is not received on time.
- On-line payments can be scheduled in advance.
- The plan is not available to Graduate, Physician Assistant or Part-Time Undergraduate students.
- The use of this prepayment plan does not affect awards of financial aid.



The optional fall and spring payment plans are as follows:

Spring Payment Plan 3	3	Dec 5 – Feb 5

Step 3

Calculate the estimated semester's cost.

Step 4

Review the Monthly Payment Plan amounts and follow through with enrolling in the plan.

It is not Bryant University's policy to grant extensions for tuition payments. If families are unable to pay under option I or option II, it is recommended that they contact the Office of Financial Aid to discuss borrowing alternatives.
